

EMERGENCY REPAIRS

In the event of an emergency which necessitates repairs to a school district in excess of the statutory competitive quotation threshold or the statutory competitive bid threshold in order to correct or control the situation and to prevent the closing of school, the provisions relating to competitive bidding shall not apply.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to obtain certification from the area education agency administrator stating such repairs in excess of either the competitive quotation or competitive bid thresholds were necessary to prevent the closing of the school.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to notify the board as soon as possible considering the circumstances of the emergency.
