Waiver of Student Fees (Drivers Education)

Students whose families meet the income guidelines for free and reduced price lunch, the Family Investment Program (FIP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), transportation assistance under open enrollment, or who are in foster care are eligible to have their drivers education fee waived or partially waived. Parents or students who believe they may qualify for temporary financial hardship should complete the *Free/Reduced application form which you will be receiving from the Food Service Department with dates they will be available*. Those eligible for Free/ Reduced price lunches last spring will expire September 10, 2017. New applications must be completed or lunches become full price after September 10, 2017.

Insurance Forms and Bus Route Schedules

Student insurance forms are available at each building and the Administration Office. If parents do not exercise the option of student insurance, the school does not provide medical coverage for accidents or injuries to students.
